RECOVERY MONTH PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, behavioral health is an essential part of health and one's overall wellness; and **WHEREAS**, prevention of mental and/or substance use disorders works, treatment is effective, and recovery is vital to the well-being of the individual and the community; and **WHEREAS**, proactively acknowledging and treating mental and/or substance use disorders is essential to achieving healthy lifestyles, both physically and emotionally; and

WHEREAS, we must encourage relatives and friends of people with mental and/or substance use disorders to implement preventive measures, recognize the signs of a problem, and guide those in need to appropriate treatment and recovery support services; and
