WHEREAS, participant Counties have entered into the County Electronic Services System 28E Agreement; WHEREAS, the Electronic Services System was created in 2005 and has implemented electronic recording and electronic transactions in each county and has developed a model statewide land record information system and website to provide electronic access to records and information in the State;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the recent amendments b the lowa legislature, the parties seek to amend and Substitute the County Electronic Services System 28E Agreement and in the process allow the system to contract directly for services thereby eliminating the financial liability of the Iowa County Recorders Association for the direct contractual actions of the Electronic Services System while at the same time allowing for a representative governance system assuring continued leadership by elected County Recorders across the State;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BOONE COUNTY that this County does hereby enter into an amended and substituted County Electronic Services System 28E Agreement. The Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors is hereby empowered and directed to execute the Amended and Substituted County Electronic Services System 28E Agreement on behalf of this County.
