A. Application for Conditional Use Permit # 2021-007 Submitted by Erickson Trucking D/B/A Lincoln Homes. Curtis Erickson is requesting a Conditional Use Permit to allow for a ministorage unit to be located at 971 222nd Dr. The property is currently commercially zoned and therefore a conditional use permit is required.
