We, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio County Board of Canvassers of Boone County, do hereby certify the following to be a true and correct abstract of the votes cast in this County at the Special Election held on the 5th day of April, 2011 on the question-

Shall the following public measure be adopted?


“Shall the Board of Directors of the United Community School District in the Counties of Boone and Story, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose an instructional support tax in an amount (after taking into consideration instructional support state aid) of not exceeding 10% of the total of regular program district cost for the budget year and moneys received under Iowa Code section 257.14 as a budget adjustment in the budget year, and be authorized annually, as determined by the Board, to levy an instructional support property tax upon all the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, and an instructional support income surtax imposed annually, the percent of income surtax to be determined annually by the Board for each budget year to be imposed upon the state individual income tax of each income taxpayer resident in the School District on December 31, 2011, and each year thereafter, to be used for any general fund purpose?”


