Longhorn moved, Bryant seconded the motion to approve the following items on the CONSENT AGENDA: April 14, 15 & 20, 2026 meeting minutes; accepted resignation from Kyle Neuendorf, Conservation Naturalist effective April 3, 2026; approved hiring Mitch Sorber, PRN Don Williams Golf Course Aide at \$16 per hour effective April 20, 2026; approved Application for Special Class C Retail Alcohol License & Outdoor Service for Ottawa Vineyards LLC (aka The Cellar Winery); approval of Secondary Roads claims #30350 to #30367 and other county claims #180426 to #180503 totaling \$148,748.73 and issuance of warrants #101443 to #101528 in payment of the same; approval of drainage claims #1236 to #1238 totaling \$7,389.88 and issuance of warrants #1665 to #1672 in payment of the same. Longhorn moved Bryant seconded motion to accept the low bid from JB Holland Construction, Inc of Decorah Iowa for \$876,090.00 per the recommendation of the Engineer for the Landfill Leachate Pump Station and Forcemain Project. Public Hearing closed at 9:32 a.m. Bryant moved Longhorn seconded motion to adopting Resolution 26-15 "To Approve Elected Officials Salaries & FY27 Budget." All ayes. Motion carried.

Bryant moved Longhorn seconded motion to approve the First Reading of Ordinance #169: Request to consider an amendment to Boone County Zoning Ordinance #88-Stormwater Management Standards for Boone County. All ayes. Motion carried.
